BASIC QUALIFICATIONS

- Four-year college degree is required with emphasis in Communications or Journalism, min. 3.0 GPA
- No more than three years professional experience

- Must be willing to sign a two-year employment contract

COLLEGE ASSOCIATE PROGRAM

The Fox News College Associate Program is a paid internship experience for currently enrolled college students.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be enrolled in accredited college or university pursuing a bachelor or graduate degree
- Resume and cover letter detailing why you should be selected for this program
- Strong academic record - minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA or above to be considered
- Current class standing of sophomore or above (30 credits)
- Prior relevant work / internship experience
- Committed and available to work entire semester / summer
- Students are responsible for their own housing and transportation
- College credit is NOT required to be eligible for the program
- Must have unrestricted authorization to work in the U.S. without a visa or sponsorship (CPT-seeking candidates not accepted)

FOX NEWS MULTIMEDIA REPORTERS



The Fox News Multimedia Reporter Training Program (MMR) was created to strengthen our breaking newsgathering capability, increase content production for all platforms and contribute to our ongoing mission to invest in emerging talent.

It is a two-year training program for aspiring broadcast journalists at the number one cable network in the country, Fox News. Multimedia Reporters operate as one-person-bands with the ability to go live virtually anywhere, anytime. They contribute a steady flow of content to our digital, radio and television properties, complementing our ongoing initiative to unify the content-based teams instead of platform-specific teams.

The MMRs use P2 cameras, Adobe Premiere editing and LiveU to stream video. Each day they gather news information, conduct live and taped interviews, write stories and deliver news reports on all media platforms. The MMRs initiate research, pitch stories, shoot and edit video, and present the material in an engaging manner that spans all Fox News platforms. Through this comprehensive experience, MMRs are able to develop a skill set that is essential to being an excellent multimedia journalist.

At the program's inception, MMRs are trained at Fox News' New York City headquarters for an intensive week-long, hands-on technical training session before being dispatched to their coverage location. Once dispatched, reporters receive daily guidance and feedback from management. Whether it's an assignment manager reviewing daily pitches, a senior vice president evaluating production and writing skills or a veteran correspondent critiquing storytelling, Fox News challenges the MMRs to continually hone their journalistic skills and capabilities.

Candidates are selected from a combination of sources including the Fox News College Associate Intern Program. Candidate must be able to work independently, have outstanding time management skills and complete required assignments on deadline. Strong working knowledge of technical aspects of television news production preferred, including digital and web-based newsgathering tools and non-linear editing such as Adobe Premiere.

To be considered, a four-year college degree is required preferably with an emphasis in Communications or Journalism. Candidates must also have a strong academic record, minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. We are also looking for graduates who have had prior relevant work/internship experience however, no more than 3 years professional experience. Candidates must have unrestricted authorization to work in the USA without a visa or sponsorship. Candidates must also have a valid driver's license and be able to lift 40 pounds.
